International Goitzsche-Motorboat race event Bitterfeld / Germany

On the lake of Goitzsche / Bernsteinsee / Isle of Pouch

Course: 3 buoys Length of lap: 1600 m

4 Classes and Championships:

World Championship	F 500	3 heats with 8 laps each and if qualifying heats are necessary 2 heats with 6 laps each

The organizer reserved the right to cancel races if in individual classes less then 8 participants are present.

5. Conducting of Races

The races are conducted in accordance with:

- the applicable UIM Regulations
- the regulations of the DMYV supplementary regulations that may be issued
- the races can be interrupted by the German Water Guard at any time

The race takes place on a circuit of a length of 1.600 m per lap. The heats are run anti-clockwise. The race is considered finished when the **winner** crosses the finishing line. The entire following driver still in the race will be flagged down and classified and given the respective points in the classification.

The precondition for the classification is that the driver will see the checkered flag.

Stopped Race:

A race will be stopped consequently due to an accident (blow over, rolling aside,

collision, submerging of a boat etc.) as well as one or more persons are plunged into the water and the continuation of the race may endanger this persons. A stopped race is a race, which is interrupted by the OOD after the start. The stopping of the race will be decided by the officer of the day only; he alone is responsible for it! A stopped race will only be repeated once over full distance! Refueling is allowed - According to art. 311.01 UIM- Regulations.

F 500 stopped races will be, if necessary, repeated twice, first restart full distance with refueling! Second restart for the rest of the laps minus one, without refueling, according to F 500-UIM-Regulations, page 462 of the UIM rulebook.

Minimum age 16 years. The participants must be in the possession of a valid driver's license

<u>Limit date for entries: 27th July 2006</u> - in the hands of the organizer.

The entry fees for the classes OSY 400 and FR 1000 are € 65.--, after the 27th July 2006 € 130,--. If a Driver starts in more than one class he have to pay only one entry fee.

No fees for classes F 500, F 250 and F 125.

It is possible to transfer the entry fees until 28th July 2006 to account number 512 33 44 01 of the Deutsche Bank (bank number 10070024).

Drivers who fail to send in their registered entry forms in due time, according to the advance programme/regulations, may lose all their travel money.

Entries are to be made on the enclosed official entry form. The entry forms must be signed personally by the driver. Entries from foreign participants must be authorized by their National Association (with stamp / signature on the entry form). Entries of participants, less than 18 years old, must be signed by the parents or a guardian.

Entries which are sent without the entry fee are invalid.

Travel money

F 500 according UIM rule book page 466 F 250 and F 125 € 160,--OSY 400 and FR 1000 no travel money In case of entries after the 27th July 2005 in the F 500, F 250 and F 125 the concerned drivers do not get travel money.

7.Starting numbers

Competitors will be informed of their starting numbers with the entry confirmation. In as far as possible the organizer will be try to give competitors who have their own permanent starting numbers these numbers. These starting numbers must correspond with UIM regulations as regards type and size. Boats that are insufficiently marked will not be classified (UIM § 206)

Participants with their first license will start with a red number on a white background.

8. Scutineering

Friday, August, 11 10.00 am to 07.00 pm Saturday, August, 12 07.30 am to 07.00 pm

Registration of documents takes place in the race-office - paddock -. Drivers must personally submit the following documents:

Int. driver's license valid for 2006
(or first license of the DMYV)
Valid immersion-test only for classes F 500 and FR 1000 (only if the boat is equipped with a cockpit)

- Insurance documents pursuant to art. 12 of these regulation.

Before the practice is started, each boat with engine must be presented to the Technical scrutineers together with the following items:

- Valid measurements certificate and for Formula 500 a mandatory Logbook as well!
- Crash helmet (according to UIM § 205.07)
- Life jacket (according to UIM § 205.06)
- Paddle (if mandatory)

The driver's card, obtains in the race-office, shall be handed over to the scrutineers who will keep it. Alterations of the engine suspension and the steering equipment are subject to scrutineering. After an accident (timed/un-timed practice, race) the crashed boat must be presented to the technical scrutineers again!

8a. Post race technical Checking

After the race the boats all classes will be weighed including the residual fuel, but without residual water (in accordance with the UIM – Reg. 522.04). After each race the first three boats in the classification must be presented to the technical scrutineers (parc fermé). Additional boats may be claimed by the scrutineers.

9. Noise Level

According to the UIM Regulations § 504.03.

10. Practice

Please see enclosed time table!
Practice outside the official practice period leads to suspension.
Practice course = race course

11. Driver's briefing

The attendance at the drivers briefing on Saturday and Sunday is mandatory. The attendance at the drivers briefing on Friday is only mandatory for drivers which will participate in the Friday practice. Delayed participants will be penalized with € 50,-. Time: please see time table.

11a. Alcohol test (UIM-Reg. § 205.02)

The organizer reserves the right to breathalyzer all persons in the pit area at any time during the practice and race days to test for alcohol (UIM § 205.02.02). If the blood alcohol concentration is higher than admissible the concerned person will be expelled of the pit area and the driver of this person's team will be disqualified of the race. The same punishment is valid if any person refuses the test.

11b. Drug control

The organizer reserves the right to check every person inside of the pit area at any time during the practice and race days to test for drugs. If any person is under influence of drugs will be expelled of the pit area and the driver of this persons team will be disqualified of the race. The same punishment is valid if any person refuse the test.

12. Exclusion form liability

The participants (competitor, driver, owner and holder of the boats) take part in the event at their own risk. They bear the sole law responsibility under civil law and criminal for all damage caused by them or the boat used, if no exclusion of liability is agreed. By submitting their entries the competitors, riders and competitors waive their right to proceed or have recourse against

- the UIM , MRC, DMYV, its president, members or its staff, both employed and voluntary
- the constituent clubs of the DMYV
- the organizer, its officials, stewards and assistants,
- the owner of the land as well as the owner of the premises used, against the carrier of the course, his officials and functionaries,
- the participants and other mechanics as well as their own mechanics,
- the authorities, services provided by industry and other persons,
- connected with the organization of the event,

for any kind of damage suffered in connection with the event except for damage from the injury of life, body or health which are based on the deliberate or negligent breach of duty – also by a legal representative or a vicarious agent of the group of persons released from liability – and except for other damage based on a deliberate or grossly negligent breach of duty – also by al legal representative or a vicarious agent of the group of persons released from liability,

against:

- the other participants (competitors, riders), their assistants, the owners, registered keepers of other boats
- their own competitor, their own rider, passenger (other special agreements between/among riders, passengers have preferences) and own assistants

they waive claims of any kind of damage that originate in connection with the competition (untimed/timed practice, warm-up, race, heat special stage), except for damage from the violation of life, the body or health which are based on a deliberate or negligent breach of duty — also by a legal representative or a vicarious agent of the group of persons released from duty — and except for other damage that is based on a deliberate or grossly negligent breach of duty - also by al legal representative or a vicarious agent of the group of persons released from duty.

The exclusion from liability becomes effective for all parties concerned upon submission of the entry form to the organizer.

The liability waiver applies to claims for any legal reason and in particular to claims for damages based on contractual and non-contractual liability remains unaffected by the above exclusion from liability.

Exclusions from implied liability remain unaffected by the above exclusion from liability.

Insurances

During the practices and the races the participants (drivers and holders) are insured by the organizer for damages for the following amount of coverage:

- € 2.556.469 for personal injuries,
- € 1.022.584 for each person,
- € 1.022.584 for damage to property,
- € 1.022.584 for pecuniary loss.

Damages of drivers to each other driver are **not insured**.

All foreign drivers must prove that they have a **personal accident insurance** cover for the following minimum amounts:

- € 26.000 in case of death,
- € 52.000 in case of disablement with 200% progression
- € 20.000 for medical costs

Insurance-Documents of foreign participants will only be accepted if, together with the documents required, a German translation certified by the insurer is submitted.

Participants who cannot furnish proof of this insurance cover must take out the insurance cover required on the spot.

The organizer has taken out a personal accident insurance covering the spectators in case of disablement as well as an accident insurance covering the officials and functionaries.

Boats and vehicles within the paddock are not insured by the organizer and are there at the owner's risk

13. Reservations

The organizer has the right, to cancel individual races because of too few drivers, (less than eight drivers) to cancel or interrupt races or individual heats wholly or partly if the weather conditions or the safety of the drivers make this necessary, or to postpone or cancel the race for compelling reasons. The organizer is entitled to reject drivers without giving reasons.

14. Classification

According to the UIM-Regulations § 318 and F 500 Rules.

15. Prizes

According to the UIM-Regulations § 322 – F 500, F250, F125 according to the formula-rules.

16. Protests

According to art. 403 of the UIM – Regulations, Protest- fee: **80** € (UIM § 403.02)

Periods allowed for protest:

- against the scrutineering 1 hour after completion of scrutineering

against incidents in the race:: 1 hour after completion of the concerned

race

against the classification: 1 hour after publishing of results

Protests against timekeeping as well as collective protests are not authorized.

In the case of technical protests the organizer is entitled to demand an advance appropriate amount (€ 255,--) from the competitor for disassembly or assembly work as the case may be.

17. Supplementary Regulations

The organizer has the right to issue further regulations in addition to these regulations, which are as binding as these regulations. The interpretation of these regulations is exclusively in the hands of the judges. The decision of the judges is binding. In case of doubt only the German text of these regulations is decisive.

2. Camping: from August 10th 02.00 pm until August 14th 12.00 am on a separate camping.

Price: 15 € per tent or parking space per day, supplementary a rubbish deposit of 20 €, to pay in advance in the race office.

The tenant get back the deposit if the parking space is clean after leaving.

19. Victory Ceremony and Prize Giving Ceremony

The Prize Giving Ceremony takes place after the protest deadline of the last heat of the event on Sunday, August 13, 2006 in the stage besides the paddock. The participants are requested to come to the Prize Giving Ceremony in appropriate clothing.

20. General

All drivers and crew members have to wear clean, respectable clothing. The upper and the lower part of the body (the knees as well) must be covered at any time. Closed shoes are mandatory as well.

Any disrespectful behaviour from a driver or a crew member against an organizing member will be penalized by a financial punishment of € 50.-. In heavy cases: Yellow card.

The boat assembling station/area must be covered underneath the boat with a liquid waste-soaking pad of the size 2x3 meters. The place must be kept clean all the time. Waste disposal bags and trashcans must be used (not for environmental pollution waste!)

Each driver is responsible for his own disposal of environmental pollution waste (pads, cleaning cloth, waste oil) there is no discard of environmental pollution waste at the track possible.

It is strictly forbidden to meals with camping equipment (grill, barbeque etc. in the pits).

In case of any contravention the organizer reserves the right to expel the concerned persons <u>and</u> to disqualify the driver of the concerned team. This is valid for all regulations of this advance program and all following supplementary regulations.


