#### Start:

The start will be a jetty start with engines dead according to the rule 307.03 of the UIM Rule Book. Early start will be punished by the rule 307.04 of the UIM Rule Book. To have the boats placed on the jetty in time is the drivers responsibility.

Fuel:

Fuel will not be available on the venue. Fuel is according to the UIM Rule Book Rule No. 508 (508.01 and 508.05) (Mol evo 95) 1,20 EUR/ Liter

#### Weighing:

In the course of the race each boat has to be prepared for the weighing procedure carried out by the technical committee.

#### Alcohol and drugs:

Drivers and mechanics should follow the rule No. 205.02.02 of the UIM Rule Book concerning alcohol and drugs.

#### Prize giving:

Venue: the platform within the pit-area

Time: 18.30 on the 19th August 2007(after the expiry of the protest time).

Race numbers and national flags, sponsor's stickers

Competitors are allowed to use their own race numbers provided they were given in advance together with the entry form and if it is ensured not to have two boats with the same race numbers. In the latter case the rule 206.02 of the UIM Rule Book is to be applied.

The race number and the national flag have to be clearly distinguished on both sides of the hull during the race in accordance with the rules 206.01 and 206.02 of the UIM Rule Book.

The Organizer has the right to put the local sponsors' stickers on both sides of all race boats.

Pit area:

On entry the organizers will give pit-passes to those persons who are allowed to enter the pit area.

The chief pit and jetty officer will ensure the order and discipline of the pit area whose instructions should be followed by each and every participant.

On arrival the chief pit officer will appoint the location of every participant in the pit area.

Teams planning to take part in the race with a number of participants are requested to inform the organizers in advance (together with the entry form) how big the necessary area should be to place their lorries and tents.

Boats once settled in the pit area are not allowed to move without the permission of the Technical Committee.

Safety guarding of the pit area during the nights will be ensured.

## International jury:

Taking part in the work of the international jury requires the official mandates from the National Federations. Thus members of the international jury should present their credentials at the 'Buro' not later than during the first drivers briefing on Saturday.

#### Time schedule:

Is given in the enclosed appendix. In case of need times schedule can be changed by OOD.

11. Entry: 108.03

Entries should be sent by mail or fax letter on an official entry form till he latest of 05<sup>th</sup> August 2007.

# 12. Insurance:

All drivers must have their own life insurance. The third party insurance will be provided by the Organizer – Főnix MSE. The fee of the third party insurance (EUR 40 or HUF 10.000) is to be paid for the organizer.

#### 13. Sound absorption.

According to the rule 504 of the UIM Rule Book. Continuously will be checked during the trainings by the Race Committee. The results of the measuring process will be published on the notice board.

## 14. Technical inspection:

The exact time of the scrutinering is given in the enclosed time schedule. The scrutinering will be carried out by the organizers according to the rule 502.01 of the UIM Rule Book.

Regarding the weight limit rules weighing before the race is possible.

The official weighing of the boats cannot be protested.

It is the competitors responsibility and task to suspend their boats properly.

## 15. Drivers briefing:

The venue and the time of the briefings are given in the time schedule. Drivers delayed from the drivers briefing should bear a penalty of 25.000.- HUF (100 EUR).

Drivers not attending the drivers meetings can be excluded from participating in the race.

## 16. Protests

Protest must be handed in writing with the fee of 80 EUR in accordance with the rule 403 of the UIM Rule Book.

## 17. Awards:

Participants of Formula 1000 European Championship Run, T-850 World Championship and the 0-250 International race will be awarded according the UIM rules.

#### 18. Others:

In all other matters related to the venue and which are not regulated by this Advance Programme the rules of the 2006 UIM Rule Book are to be followed.
