TEXT IN 2015 RULEBOOK

 (\ldots)

A non-European driver can only compete in any UIM European titled event if:

- a) It is a series,
- b) He/she competes on equal terms for any start/prize monies and/or event trophies,
- c) He can accumulate points for the Series,
- d) His results will be counted when calculating points to go forwards to the final series point count, but cannot be awarded the UM title of European Champion unless he is the holder of a valid European National Authority license at the last of the Series or the last event he took part in.

TEXT FOR 2015 SEASON

Delete the entire rule

(...)

A non-European driver can only compete in any UIM European titled event if:

- a) It is a series,
- b) He/she competes on equal terms for any start/prize monies and/or event trophies,
- c) He can accumulate points for the Series,
- d) His results will be counted when calculating points to go forwards to the final series point count, but cannot be awarded the UM title of European Champion unless he is the holder of a valid European National Authority license at the last of the Series or the last event he took part in.

JUSTIFICATION

Conflicting rule.

This part of the rule is against the beginning of the rule which says that: "A non-European may be proclaimed European Champion provided he holds a current valid International Licence. The same applies for other continents.
