Art. 1 CLASSES AND RULES

- 1.1 U.I.M. F2 Catamarans with power units conforming to the SST 200 regulation. All boats must be equipped according to UIM Blue Pages F2 Rules as per the 2021 UIM Rulebook.
- **1.2** U.I.M. Rules 2021 (Blue and White pages) and the Advance Programme for F2.
- 1.3 The Organizers and Race Officials retain the right to announce additional rules and regulations specifically for the race mentioned in this advance program. These rules and regulations shall be in compliance with the rules and regulations of the U.I.M. and shall be equally mandatory as many other rules and regulations of these races. The Race Officials shall also inform drivers about these additional rules and regulations during the official driver's briefings.
- **1.4** Official Language of the Event: **English**

. Art. 3 PARTICIPATION IN THE U.I.M. F2 WC ROUNDS

- 3.1 Drivers will <u>only</u> be admitted to the races after providing the following (original documents must be presented and copies handed over to the Race Secretary):
- **3.2** Official Letter of Start Approval from their National Authority
- **3.3** Measurement Certificate, International License, Personal Insurance
- **3.4** Immersion Test Certificate
- **3.5** Documents of Medical Examination
- 3.6 Insurance Documents in English
- **3.7** Acknowledgement of the Anti-doping Rules

Art. 4 APPLICATION

- **4.1** Application shall be fully completed and approved by the respective National Authority.
- 4.2 Entries must be sent before **September 30**th **2021** to the Portuguese Powerboat Federation (FPM) Official E-mail Address: fpm@fpmotonautica.org. All applications will be confirmed by an e-mail reply from FPM. If a driver has not received such confirmation, he/she is responsible to contact the organizers to verify the application. Entries after **September 30**th **2021, 23:59h,** can be rejected.





4.3 All national drivers have to make their entry to same e-mail addresses mentioned in 4.2. If anyone has problems, please contact the FPM: fpm@fpmotonautica.org within the time limit. Entry form must be sent in by the deadline.

Art. 5 INSURANCE

- **5.1** All drivers must carry their medical insurance, valid in European Union, and are responsible for their own personal and accident insurance.
- **5.2** Third-party insurance, which amounts to **90,00 EURO** per driver, can be bought during registration. An invoice will be given to each driver/team.
- 5.3 Third-party insurance: Drivers/Teams who brings with them from their own country, must cover a minimum of EUR 100.000,00€. Insurance document must be written in English as well in their native language and confirmed from the driver's own NA, in order to be accepted and authorized.
- **5.4** Members of the crew and any boat under their national age of majority must provide written evidence of parental consent to participate in any race or practice.

Art. 6 RACE COURSE FOR V. V. RÓDÃO RACE

6.1 See attached at the end of the document – Official Drawing of the Race Course.

Number of Buoys: 6 Left (Orange) and 1 Right (Yellow)

The course is a 7-pin course; One lap is **1.577 m**

F2 will have a race of <u>approx. 35 min.</u> duration, with a limit of 90 min., including any re-starts.

The course will be in accordance with the U.I.M. Water Registration and can be changed before the race.





Art. 7 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

- **7.1** According to U.I.M. rules
- 7.2 The minimum age for all drivers racing international races is 16 years old (UIM 203.04.01).

Art. 8 DRIVER'S MEETINGS

- 8.1 Mandatory driver's and radiomen meetings will be held on 16th and 17th October, according to the provisional time schedule attached to this Advance-Programme.
- **8.2** Place and time, if changed, for driver's and radiomen meetings will be announced during driver's registration.
- **8.3** Driver's and radiomen meetings shall be chaired by the U.I.M. Race Director and the Official Language of the meetings shall be **English**.
- **8.4** Driver's and radiomen who are absent at the meetings, shall be excluded from participating in the events of that day and shall receive a penalty of **200,00 EURO** to pay directly to the Race Secretary.

Art. 9 PIT AREA

9.1 The PIT Area shall be closed, secured and restricted territory available to the technical staff of the teams, drivers and their equipment **only**. All technical preparation of the boats and their launch into the water shall be informed at the PIT Area.





- **9.2** Any open fire or smoking shall be **strictly prohibited** in the PIT Area.
- **9.3** Every boat in the PIT area **shall** have a fire extinguisher located in close vicinity of the boat.
- **9.4** No animals shall be allowed in the PIT Area.
- 9.5 The PIT Area will be guarded from 15th October until 17th October 2021 | 24.00h
- **9.6** PIT Area will be closed during night hours from **22h00 to 7h00** and nobody without permission from race officials shall be allowed there.
- 9.7 PIT Area passes and Pontoon Passes shall be provided by the organizers at the time of the arrival of the teams. Each team is responsible for indicating the number of necessary PIT Area passes at the time of application and registration.
- **9.8** All team staff and drivers must wear appropriate team clothing and closed to shoes at the PIT Area <u>all</u> times.
- 9.9 Any further rules and requirements relating to the PIT Area and its use shall be provided to the teams at registration and/or driver's meetings and posted on the designated board in PIT Area.
- **9.10** Any violation in the PIT Area shall be subject to a fine. Teams shall be informed about the applicable fines at the time of registration and posted on the designated board in the PIT Area. The Pits Officer shall bear sole responsibility for ensuring compliance with rules in the PIT Area.
- 9.11 Due to restricted space at the PIT Area, <u>all</u> vehicles and trailers must be parked at the parking area, which will be signalized at the arrival.

 It's not allowed to keep trailers, trucks or cars at the PIT Area, unless truck or trailer is made as service equipment and it's necessary to fix to the pit canopy. In case of failure of this rule, sanctions will be applied accordingly.





Art. 10 LAUNCHING OF THE BOATS INTO THE WATER

- **10.1** Launch of the boats into the water shall be performed with cranes in specially marked places only. Slipway is **NOT** available in that area.
- 10.2 A crane will be available on October 15th from 15:00 PM. Two cranes will be available to launch the boats on October 16th and 17th at 9:00 AM onwards.
- 10.3 Instructions of the crane operators must be observed at all times during the launch of the boat into the water. Equipment must comply with the U.I.M. rules (205.12).

Art. 11 PRACTICE

- **11.1** Practice will be allowed only after the technical inspection of the boat on the course as it will be laid out for the race.
- 11.2 Practice will be allowed only during the official practice sessions according to the final time schedule of the event. Course will be closed for practice during any other time and any boat on the course during this time, shall be subject to the disqualification from the event.

• Art. 12 START

- **12.1** The start will be dead engine start from a jetty as per U.I.M. Rules White and Blue pages.
- **12.2** The start will be signaled with lights.





- 12.3 On the start jetty each driver can be accompanied by not more than 3 (three) mechanics.
- 12.4 It's the driver's responsibility to place the boat on the start in time. Late starters can only join the field by following the instructions of the Pontoon Marshall.
- 12.5 Boats which do not line up with the boat next to them with 20 (twenty) seconds of being requested to do, it will be financially penalized 150,00 EURO.

Art. 13 FINISH

After the first driver completes the race distance, each boat driven by the power of its own engine and having completed, at last, 70% of the laps of the winning boat will be classified as finisher.

Art. 14 WEIGHING

14.1 During the event each boat must be prepared for the weighing procedure, which shall be carried out by the technical committee at any requested time. The weighing of the boats cannot be protested.





. Art. 15 RESULTS AND PROTESTS

- **15.1** Results will be published on a designated board in the PIT Area.
- Any protests must be submitted to the Race Secretary in English, according to the **U.I.M. Rule 403**.
- **15.3** Protest fee is **80,00 EURO** and it's payable at the time of submission of the protest.

Art. 16 INTERNATIONAL JURY

Participation in the international jury shall be subject to the official mandate from the National Federations. All members of the international jury shall present their credentials to the Race Secretary during registration on <u>15th October 2021</u>.

Art. 17 PRIZES

- **17.1** The first three places of the Grand Prix's will be awarded with cups and prizes.
- 17.2 All drivers and teams of each event must attend the Prize giving ceremony after the finish of the final Grand Prix race on October 17th, as per the time schedule.
- **17.3** Everyone must attend the prize giving ceremony in their team's full uniform.
- 17.4 Prize giving ceremony should take place within <u>approx. 30 minutes</u> after the conclusion of the race. The top three finishers must have to be present on the podium. If they are not present, a penalty **of 1.000,00 EURO** will be applied.





. Art. 18 NOISE AND ENVIRONMENT

- **18.1** Driver of every boat is responsible that the engine does not exceed noise levels at **all** times, as specified in **U.I.M. Rule 505**.
- 18.2 Every member must be taken to avoid spilling fuel or oil. To ensure this, an absorbent carpet shall be used (U.I.M. Rule 703).
- **18.3** Every member of each team is responsible to take care of the environment around their tents, boats and equipment.
- 18.4 Infringement of these environmental-protective rules will result a fine of **200,00 EURO** to pay directly to the Race Secretary.

Art. 19 ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

- **19.1** Drivers and Mechanics should follow the rule **No. 205.02.02** of the U.I.M. Rule Book concerning alcohol and drugs.
- 19.2 Random test may be carried out at any time during the event by "Antidoping organization".

 Please be aware of the New WADA's definition of alcohol as a drug and the consequences this gives.

Art. 20 BUOYS

Any driver damaging or breaking a buoy (including anchor and weight parts) shall be subject to a **200,00 EURO** penalty, payable immediately to the Race Secretary. Should the responsible driver fail to pay the penalty fees of buoy infringement, then he/she is prohibited from participating at the following race events of the Time Schedule.





20.2 Once payments are made the driver is allowed to re-join the events of the Time Schedule. Remaining buoys and anchors belong to the organizer.

Art. 21 ACCOMODATION AND TRANSPORT

- 21.1 According to the pandemic situation of COVID 19, and as indicated by the local health authorities, all accommodation reservations must be made until September 30th 2021 through the following email address: martapbastos@gmail.com or contact the reservations numbers +351913313911. The price for room is 60€ and must be paid at the race secretariat.

Art. 22 FUEL

22.1 Racing fuel can be purchased at the **event's official fuel station**:

Combustíveis Rodense, Lda (BP service station) Estrada Nacional, 18 6030-233 Vila Velha de Ródão

- **22.2** The cost per litter will the prevailing price in Portugal during the days of the event (to be announced at the registration time)
- **22.3** Teams are **not allowed** to use their own fuel bought from others fuel stations.
- **22.4** Fuel will be checked and tested during the event by the Technical Committee according to the U.I.M. rules





Art. 23 TRAVEL EXPENSES AND PRIZE MONEY

- 23.1 Prize Money As per U.I.M. F2 rule
- 23.2 Travel Money As per U.I.M. F2 rule

Art. 24 ADDITIONAL RULES

- 24.1 The Organizer reserves the right to make any changes and regulations given in this advance-programme. All changes will be published in writing and announced during the driver's briefing.
- **24.2** The Organizer invites the participants to use their national flags and team uniforms.
- 24.3 By signing the entry form, each participant accepts the rules and regulations of this advance program, organizer instructions and U.I.M. rules.
- 24.4 The Organizers <u>will not</u>, in any way, have responsibility towards the drivers, mechanics, or other participants of the event for any material damages incurred during or in connection with the event. Boat drivers and other participants acknowledge that they are fully aware of the risks associated with participation in the races and shall take part in the races at their own risk.





The Local Organizer provides stickers of Local Sponsors of the event. These stickers are <u>mandatory</u> stickers from the Local Organizer and should be attached onto both sponsors of each participating boat (202.02.24).

The organizer reserves the right to add advertising according to U.I.M.

- **24.6** Each sticker should have a maximum of <u>30x10cm</u>.
- **24.7** The Organizer recommends teams and their representatives to not interfere with local sponsors of the event.

Art. 25 IMMERSION TEST

- **25.1** As per the U.I.M. rules, all drivers <u>must</u> have a valid Immersion Test Certificate.
- **25.2** No Immersion Tests will be provided by the Local Organizer.

Art. 26 VISA REQUIREMENTS

26.1 It's the responsibility of each team and driver to obtain visa for the entry in Portugal, if necessary. Please contact your nearest Portuguese embassy or consulate to find out whether you need the visa to enter in Portugal and the requirements to apply for it.





Art. 27 IMAGE

27.1 Every participant authorizes the organizers, the partners and the media to use, free of charge, the images taken on the occasion of his participation in the World Championship Race on whom he/she could appear on any supports, including the promotional or advertising documents.



COVID-19 SPECIFIC HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES

1. GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

COVID-19 is a disease caused by the infection of the new Coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2). It is predominantly manifested by respiratory symptoms such as fever, cough and breathing difficulties. There may be other symptoms such as sore throat, muscle pain, headache and less frequently nausea/vomiting and diarrhea.

Based on current scientific evidence this virus is mainly transmitted through:

- Direct contact: spread of respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes
 or speaks that can be inhaled or land in the mouth, nose or eyes of people who are close (< 2
 meters)
- Indirect contact: contact of hands with a contaminated surface or object and then with the mouth, nose or eyes

2. GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- a) Participants will be submitted to a **COVID 19 antigen test on the arrival and on the departure**. **Each test cost € 30**.
- b) Body temperature measurement at the paddock entrance
- c) Maintain the physical social distance minimum of 2 meters between people
- d) Avoid concentrations above 10 people
- e) Wash the hands frequently with soap and water or with an alcohol-based antiseptic solution
- f) When coughing or sneezing do not use the hands. Use a tissue or forearm. Then, throw the tissue in the trash and wash the hands next
- g) Always use mask, except for the drivers with helmet and glasses
- h) Avoid physical contact
- Avoid sharing tools, equipment, pens, radios and other devices. If this happens, they should be disinfected before and after use and hands thoroughly washed
- i) Water in bottles only for exclusive personal use
- k) Use of private transport and direct flights, whenever possible, is recommended
- 1) In case of any symptoms, suspicion of being infected or having been in contact with infected persons must immediately suspend any activity and report the situation to medical services





3. ORGANIZER

The organizer must assure:

- a) Disinfection of the paddock the day before the event
- b) Enough masks and hygiene products to be provided to the Commissioners/Staff during the event
- c) No agglomeration of more than 10 people
- d) Placement of alcohol-based solution dispensers next to the entrances and exits of bathrooms, secretariat, timing, etc.
- e) A 4 meters space in the paddock between each tent.

4. DRIVERS

- a) Mandatory to wear mask when not equipped with a helmet
- b) Must not share equipment, material, drinks or other products
- c) Ensure the distance between pilot and all team members and avoid direct contact
- d) During training and race in addition to the pilot and mechanic, the physical presence of other support personnel is not allowed. The social distance must be fulfilled
- e) All the drivers/teams equipment (boat, engine, helmet, etc) must be sanitized before and after each use
- f) All teams must follow the security measures and comply with the sanitary measures established

5. DRIVERS MEETING

a) Whenever possible it will be done outdoor keeping the distance of 2 meters between the drivers and all the presents

6. SECRETARIAT

- a) Must be held in authorized areas previously sanitized or outdoor
- b) The drivers registration must be made individually and always keeping the distance of 2 meters
- c) All the drivers must use their own pen





d) It's mandatory the use of mask

7. TIMING / RACE CONTROL

- a) Distance of 2 meters between each person
- b) Place must be sanitized before and after use
- c) Mandatory the use of mask
- d) Flags must only be used by the Race Director
- e) Each person present at this place must have their own personal equipment and of communication properly sanitized before and after use

8. PRIZE GIVING CERIMONY

- a) The podium must be sufficiently wide in order to guarantee a minimum distance of 2 meters between the drivers and any person taking part in the awards ceremony
- b) Previously to the ceremony the objects of possible contact will be disinfected
- c) Mandatory the use of mask for all
- d) Any direct physical contact is forbidden in the podium
