Dear Karel,

At the present time, less than 60 days before the event, we have pleasure to **confirm the status of UIM World Championship, Circuit Classes F125/F250/F500/OSY400**, of the event to be held in Jedovnice.

We understand that participating Teams/Drivers and Officials shall be granted entry to the country and access to the place where the event will take place, without any COVID-19 specific restrictions applicable such as compulsory quarantine upon arrival.

This understanding is based on the official government regulations, stating that the persons arriving in Czech Republic are required to present the Eu Digital COVID Certificate or national certificate showing that they have completed the vaccination, or having recovered from a Covid-19 infection occurred in the last 180 days, or to show a negative PCR test (72 hours before arrival) / negative antigen test (48 hours before arrival). Each participant is obliged to make on-line registration before entry to Czech republic: https://plf.uzis.cz/

For avoidance of any misunderstanding, the presentation of a vaccination certificate or a negative PCR test, if required, are not considered to be a restriction that would entail the withdrawal of the WC/EC status of UIM titled Events.

Please let us know if foreign drivers wishing to participate in the Event and accompanying Team staff need to perform specific administrative formalities or satisfy other requirements when entering the country, to avoid sanitary restrictions such as a quarantine.
